After a a successful grant application to the Lancaster University Friends Programme, LUBC were able to place an order for this state of the art boat. A memorised 1st VIII went along to Nottingham in early February to put the potential new purchase through it's paces and all left the water with a smile!

The only one of its kind this new prototype is the first "wing rigged" Sims VIII to be produced and judging by the reaction of the guys that rowed it; it certainly made the right impression! From its gleaming white hull to the jet back carbon fibre interior; it left all of us thinking we had not just purchased a state of the art rowing machine - but a true work of art!
